Mistletoe in Integrative Oncology

The aqueous mistletoe drops for oral use are authorised in Switzerland as a non-prescription Anthroposophic medicine (dispensing category D).

The preparation is made from the mistletoe growing on the host trees – Apple (*Malus*), Pine (*Pinus*) and Oak (*Quercus*). The manufacturing process is the same as for ISCADOR (Injections), but the solution is diluted with water after manufacturing, depending on the degree of concentration, and filled into 20ml dropper bottles.

Mistletoe oral drops are available over the counter from pharmacies in Switzerland.

Store unopened at room temperature (15–25°C).

Once opened, keep in the refrigerator at 3–8°C for up to 3 weeks.

Dosage

For individual therapy, use and dose as prescribed by the consulting physician.

Recommendations

Children and teenagers up to 16 years of age: Take once daily, starting on Mondays with 1x1 drop per year of age, up to a maximum of 10 drops. Increase by 1 drop daily until day 6 (Saturday), then take a 1-day break and start again from the beginning (sawtooth pattern).¹

From 16 years of age and above: Start on Mondays with 3x5 drops per day; increase by 1 drop per administration daily up to 3x10 drops on the 6th day (Saturday), followed by a 1-day break, then start again from the beginning (sawtooth pattern).²

Directions for use

Hold the bottle with the dropper tilted down until the drops appear and pour the desired number of drops onto a wooden or plastic spoon.

The rate of dripping will be accelerated if the bottle is held vertically. Holding the bottle at an angle can slow the dripping rate.



Avoid shaking or tapping the bottle.

Swirl the drops around in your mouth for 30 to 60 seconds to ensure good contact with the mucous membranes of your mouth before swallowing.

Contraindication:

Hypersensitivity or known allergy to mistletoe.

Side effects:

Very rarely, hypersensitivity reactions.

Composition

Viscum Mali praeparatum 3%

1 g corresponds to 1 ml (= 15 drops) and contains 150 mg fermented liquid extract of fresh apple tree mistletoe (*Viscum album* L., ssp. *album*, herba, Host tree: *Malus domestica* (Suckow) Borkh.) with fresh plant-extract ratio 1:5; Extractant: purified water; Excipients: Water for injection purposes

Viscum Pini praeparatum 0,1%/3%

1 g corresponds to 1 ml (= 15 drops) and contains 5 mg/150 mg fermented liquid extract of fresh pine mistletoe (*Viscum album* L., ssp. *austriacum* Vollm., herba, Host tree: *Pinus sylvestris* L.) with a fresh plant-extract ratio of 1:5; Extractant: purified water; Excipients: Water for injection purposes

Viscum Quercus praeparatum 0,1%/3%

1 g corresponds to 1 ml (= 15 drops) and contains 5 mg/150 mg fermented liquid extract from fresh oak mistletoe (*Viscum album* L., ssp. *album*, herba, Host trees: *Quercus robur* L., *Quercus petraea* Liebl.) with a fresh plant-extract ratio of 1:5; Extractant: purified water; Excipients: Water for injection purposes
